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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Designs a seafood traceability system — lot coding, farm and input records, processing and cold-chain logs and one-up-one-down linkage — for export, recall and buyer requirements. Use it to build credible traceability.

Purpose of this tool & output

Trace product from farm to shipment

How the output is used

Use it to trace product from farm to shipment — a traceability system setup that links each lot back to the pond.

Important cautions

Traceability is mandatory for export and recall and increasingly demanded by buyers; gaps undermine both. Align the design with EIA, MPEDA and buyer requirements and test it with a mock recall.
