Background

Guides FSSAI compliance for a food product — the right licence (registration/state/central), product category and standards, testing, labelling and claims, and hygiene/audit readiness — so your product is legal to sell. Use it before/while selling a food product. For label specifics use the Label & Legal Metrology Compliance Check.

Purpose of this tool & output

Get FSSAI right for your food product

How the output is used

Use it to get FSSAI right for your food product — the correct licence tier, product approval and packaging/label compliance on FoSCoS.

Who receives it

Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI), via the FoSCoS portal.

How to submit / file it

Apply on FoSCoS for the right tier (Registration / State / Central) with KYC, layout and product details; inspection may follow.

Fees & charges

Government fee varies by tier and years; typically modest for registration, higher for State/Central licences.

Who should vet it

A food-safety consultant for the correct tier and Schedule-4 hygiene compliance.

Important cautions

FSSAI rules are detailed and change; verify licence tier and product standards on the FSSAI portal or with a consultant.
