

Eating House Licence Guide

Food Service, Restaurants & Cloud Kitchens

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Produces a guide to the Eating House Licence (police) required for food outlets in many Indian cities — applicability, documents, conditions, process and renewal. Use it to license the premises where the city requires it. For all licences use the Licensing Roadmap.

Purpose of this tool & output

Get the police eating house licence

How the output is used

Use the guide to get the police eating house licence where required.

Who receives it

The local Police (Licensing Unit/Commissioner of Police).

How to submit / file it

Apply with the outlet, FSSAI, fire and trade documents; police verification may follow.

Fees & charges

Police licensing fee (varies by city).

Who should vet it

A local licensing consultant.

Important cautions

The Eating House Licence is required in many but not all cities and is issued by the police/licensing authority with city-specific documents and conditions (sometimes CCTV, staff verification, timings). Confirm whether your city requires it and the exact process with the local police licensing branch.
