Background

Produces a guide to obtaining the municipal Health Trade Licence for a food outlet — applicability, documents, hygiene/premises conditions, process and renewal. Use it to license the premises for food trade. For overall compliance use the Licensing Roadmap.

Purpose of this tool & output

Get the municipal health trade licence

How the output is used

Use the guide to get the municipal health trade licence for the outlet.

Who receives it

The local municipal corporation (health department).

How to submit / file it

Apply with the outlet, tenancy/NOC and hygiene documents; an inspection may follow.

Fees & charges

Municipal fee (varies by city and area).

Who should vet it

A local licensing consultant.

Important cautions

Health Trade Licence requirements, names and processes vary by municipal corporation — some cities fold it into other licences. Confirm the exact requirement and process with your local municipal/health department. Operating without required licences risks penalties and closure.
