

Landed-Cost & Cost Optimization

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Builds a landed-cost and cost-optimization approach for furniture inputs and products — full cost build-up, comparison and reduction levers — to protect margin. Use it to control input costs. For product costing use the Product Costing & Bill of Materials tool.

Purpose of this tool & output

Know true cost and cut it smartly

How the output is used

Use it to know true cost and cut it smartly — a landed-cost and cost optimization analysis across material, labour, overhead and logistics.

Who should vet it

Your CA or finance lead, to confirm the landed-cost build-up and the biggest savings before you act.

Important cautions

Compare on true landed cost (including freight, duty, wastage and financing), not sticker price, and pursue yield, design-for-cost and rework reduction as much as supplier-price negotiation. Do not cut cost by compromising quality, safety or legal-timber compliance. Validate figures against actuals.
