

Product Costing & Bill of Materials

Furniture & Home Furnishings

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Builds a bill of materials and cost sheet for a furniture product from your discrete material, labour and overhead inputs. Use it to cost and price products accurately. For the margin view use the Product Cost & Margin Calculator.

Purpose of this tool & output

Cost a product from its materials up

How the output is used

Use it to cost a product from its materials up — a product costing and bill of materials that builds the true cost per piece.

Who should vet it

Your CA or finance lead, to confirm the material, labour and overhead in the BOM cost.

Important cautions

Include realistic wood wastage and rework and allocated overhead, not just direct materials — furniture costing is often understated by ignoring these. Price above fully-loaded cost with margin for damage and returns. Validate material and labour figures against your actuals.
