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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Maps all registrations and licences a furniture business needs — entity, GST, factory and pollution (if manufacturing), legal timber, shops and establishment and export council — in sequence. Use it to get compliant. For manufacturing specifics use the Factory Licences & Pollution Guide.

Use it as your master checklist of every registration a furniture business needs — GST, factory/SPCB, shops, EPCH and more, in order.

Important cautions

Manufacturing furniture triggers factory, pollution (wood dust and finishing) and fire obligations, and all wood must be legally sourced with valid documentation. Export needs IEC and export-council registration. Requirements vary by state and scale — confirm with the relevant authorities.
