Background

Explains wood seasoning, moisture control and anti-termite and borer treatment for furniture — methods, targets and process — to prevent warping, cracking and pest damage. Use it to protect product durability. For quality use the Quality Control & Finish Standards tool.

Purpose of this tool & output

Prevent warping, cracking and pests

How the output is used

Use it to prevent warping, cracking and pests — a wood seasoning, treatment and anti-termite guide that protects quality.

Important cautions

Improperly seasoned or untreated wood warps, cracks and gets borer or termite damage after sale — the top cause of solid-wood complaints. Season to appropriate moisture for your climate and treat against pests, handling treatment chemicals safely. Kiln-seasoning gives more reliable results than air-drying alone.
