

Esports Player Contract

Gaming, Esports & Digital Entertainment

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Drafts an esports player contract with discrete terms — term, salary, winnings/content splits, obligations, image rights, welfare and exit — fair to both org and player. Use it to sign a player. Fill each term separately; obtain guardian consent for minors.

Purpose of this tool & output

Contract an esports player fairly

How the output is used

Use the draft to contract an esports player fairly — salary, tenure, image rights, conduct, welfare and buyout — reviewed by a lawyer.

Who receives it

The agreement is between the esports org and the player (and guardian, if a minor); each keeps a signed copy.

Fees & charges

Usually executed on stamp paper per your state; GST/TDS apply to the fee as per law.

Who should vet it

A sports/gaming lawyer, to make the image-rights, buyout, welfare and minor-protection terms fair and enforceable.

Important cautions

Template for guidance, not legal advice. Keep terms fair — esports is criticised for exploitative player deals; scope image rights, define splits clearly, and include welfare. For minors, obtain guardian consent and extra protections. Have a lawyer review before signing.
