

Indian Citizenship Application — Naturalisation / Registration

This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Prepares the complex, evidence-heavy application for Indian citizenship by naturalisation or registration — establishing the qualifying route and residence, assembling the long-form declarations and the documentary evidence, and preparing the field content — for a case that would otherwise be returned repeatedly.

Purpose of this tool & output

Prepare an Indian citizenship application by naturalisation or registration, with the eligibility, long-form declarations and evidentiary document set

How the output is used

Use the route determination, the long-form declarations and the documentary-evidence list to assemble and submit the citizenship application, and use the covering representation to present the residence and eligibility clearly.

Who receives it

The Ministry of Home Affairs, through the Online Indian Citizenship portal, routed via the district Collector and state government.

How to submit / file it

File the application for the qualifying route (naturalisation or registration) with the residence and status evidence, the declarations and affidavits, and the renunciation of the current citizenship where required; the oath of allegiance follows approval.

Fees & charges

The prescribed application fee for the route; a professional fee is likely given the complexity and the evidence assembly.

Who should vet it

An immigration lawyer — the route, the residence computation and the evidence are decisive and the decision rests with the Ministry of Home Affairs.

Important cautions

The residence and eligibility conditions are strict and the decision is discretionary with the Ministry of Home Affairs; incomplete evidence causes repeated returns. This is a drafting aid — have a lawyer settle it.
