Background

Assembles a properly indexed e-filing document bundle for a court matter — the paper-book with the correct order, pagination and annexure marking, the index and synopsis, and the checklist for the court or tribunal e-filing portal — and organises the case-status essentials (parties, stage, next date) so nothing is missed.

Purpose of this tool & output

Assemble a court e-filing document bundle — an indexed paper-book with the correct annexures — and track the case-status essentials

How the output is used

Use the indexed paper-book, the synopsis and the annexure marking to file the matter on the court/tribunal e-filing portal (or physically), and use the case-status essentials to track the stage and the next date so nothing is missed.

Important cautions

Every court/portal has its own format, pagination and annexure rules; a wrong index or a missing document stalls the case registration. Confirm the final filing and argue it through an advocate.
