Background

Plans an end-to-end import-export setup — the Importer-Exporter Code (IEC), the bank AD-code registration, the DGFT registrations (RCMC and scheme registrations), the ICEGATE and customs onboarding, and the export-incentive registrations — sequenced with the documents each needs, so a new exporter or importer is fully ready to ship.

Purpose of this tool & output

Plan an import-export setup — IEC, AD-code, DGFT registrations, customs onboarding and the incentive registrations

How the output is used

Use the sequenced setup plan — the IEC, the bank AD-code, the DGFT registrations (RCMC and scheme registrations), the ICEGATE/customs onboarding and the export-incentive registrations — with the documents each needs, to get fully ready to ship as an importer/exporter.

Important cautions

The applicable registrations and their order depend on the product, the market and the scheme; missing a step can hold up the first consignment. Verify each step current DGFT/customs requirement with a consultant.
