

Police Clearance Certificate (PCC) Assembly

This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Assembles a Police Clearance Certificate (PCC) application — for immigration, foreign employment or a long-term visa — with the residence-history and document set, the Passport-Seva linkage, and the guidance for cases that need a state-police or embassy-route PCC instead of the standard passport-office one.

Purpose of this tool & output

Assemble a Police Clearance Certificate application for immigration, foreign employment or a long-term visa, with the correct route and document set

How the output is used

Use the identified route and document set to apply for the PCC through Passport Seva, the state police or the Indian mission, complete the police verification, and get it apostilled or attested afterwards if the destination requires it.

Who receives it

The Regional Passport Office or Passport Seva Kendra, or the state or commissionerate police, or the Indian mission abroad — whichever route applies; the local police for verification.

How to submit / file it

Apply online on Passport Seva (or to the police or mission for those routes) with the passport, address proofs and the purpose or immigration letter, and attend the verification where required.

Fees & charges

The PCC application fee under the applicable route; any subsequent apostille or attestation carries its own charge.

Who should vet it

A visa or immigration consultant where the destination has specific PCC-format or attestation requirements; a straightforward PCC needs no professional.

Important cautions

The right route depends on the residence history and on whether you are in India or abroad, and many countries require the PCC to be apostilled or embassy-attested afterwards. Verify the format the destination accepts at the PSK or mission.
