

Commercial / Institutional / PM-KUSUM Solar Subsidy + DPR

Background

Prepares a solar subsidy or incentive application for a commercial, institutional or agricultural (PM-KUSUM) installation — with the feasibility and DPR, the capacity and cost, the applicable central or state incentive, and the document set for the nodal agency.

Purpose of this tool & output

Prepare a commercial, institutional or agricultural (PM-KUSUM) solar subsidy application with the feasibility and DPR

How the output is used

Use the feasibility, the DPR, the capacity/cost and the mapped incentive to apply to the nodal agency (state/central or the PM-KUSUM portal for agriculture), tie in the financing, and claim the subsidy after commissioning.

Who receives it

The nodal agency for the scheme — the state renewable-energy development agency or MNRE, or the PM-KUSUM implementing agency for an agricultural (solar pump / feeder) installation.

How to submit / file it

Apply to the nodal agency with the DPR, the feasibility, the capacity and cost, and the ownership/land documents; the subsidy is released against milestones or after commissioning and inspection.

Fees & charges

Application/processing charges vary by scheme and agency; the project cost is met by the applicant and the subsidy is a partial reimbursement after commissioning.

Who should vet it

A solar consultant or a chartered accountant — to confirm the DPR assumptions, the applicable central/state incentive, and the commissioning-linked claim.

Important cautions

Commercial, institutional and PM-KUSUM incentives differ in eligibility, ceiling and process, and many are capacity- or budget-capped and released after commissioning; a claim without the sanctioned DPR or outside the scheme window is rejected. Verify the current scheme with the nodal agency.
