Background

Drafts a hospital infection prevention and control (IPC) policy — hand hygiene, PPE, isolation, sterilisation, HAI surveillance and outbreak response — aligned to NABH/NCDC norms. For a data-privacy policy use the Health Data Privacy (DPDPA) Policy tool.

Purpose of this tool & output

Draft an infection-control protocol

How the output is used

Adopt the infection-control protocol to set hand-hygiene, isolation, sterilisation and surveillance rules across the facility.

Who receives it

Approved by the medical superintendent/infection-control committee; applies to all clinical and support staff.

Important cautions
