Builds a background-verification and trust protocol — police/ID verification of every technician, verified-technician communication to customers (name/photo/ID shared before visit), women-safety measures, and incident handling — so customers feel safe letting your technician in. Use it to make every home visit safe and trustworthy — a background verification and trust protocol for technicians entering homes.

Important cautions

Verifying technicians and sharing their verified identity with customers before a visit is the foundation of trust and safety (especially for women customers); treat any safety incident with utmost seriousness and involve authorities as needed.
