Background

Builds an operating playbook for pest control — service types and SOPs, mandatory licensing under the Insecticides Act, safe chemical handling and dosage, occupant/pet safety, warranty/re-treatment, and AMC recurring revenue — so you run pest control compliantly and safely. Use it for the pest line. For adding it use the Service Line Feasibility Study.

Purpose of this tool & output

Run pest control legally, safely, effectively

How the output is used

Use it to run pest control legally, safely and effectively — a pest-control playbook covering licensed chemicals, safety and treatment.

Important cautions

Pest control requires licensing under the Insecticides Act (registered operator, approved insecticides, trained applicators); using unapproved chemicals or unlicensed operation is illegal and unsafe. Protect occupants, children, pets and food. Pest is excellent recurring/AMC revenue.
