Background

Builds a route and travel-optimization approach — clustering jobs by area, sequencing a technician day to minimise travel, and zoning technicians — so technicians spend time on jobs, not commuting (the biggest hidden cost). Use it to cut travel. For productivity use the Technician Productivity Improvement tool.

Purpose of this tool & output

Cut the travel that eats technician time

How the output is used

Use it to cut the travel that eats technician time — a route and travel optimisation that packs jobs by area.

Important cautions

Travel is the biggest hidden cost in home services; zoning technicians and clustering jobs by area lifts jobs-per-day and reduces fatigue. Balance route efficiency against honouring customer slots.
