

Vendor / Supplier Agreement

Home & Repair Services

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Drafts a vendor/supplier agreement for spare parts, materials or equipment with each term separate — supply scope and rates, genuine-parts/quality guarantee, credit, delivery, and term — so your parts supply is reliable and genuine. Use it to lock suppliers. For genuine-parts policy use the Genuine Parts & No-Cheating Policy.

Purpose of this tool & output

Contract parts/materials suppliers on discrete terms

How the output is used

Use the draft to contract parts and materials suppliers on discrete terms — supply, price, genuineness, returns and credit — reviewed by a lawyer.

Who receives it

The agreement is between you and the parts/materials supplier; each keeps a signed copy.

Fees & charges

Stamp duty per your state stamp act; GST is handled in invoicing.

Who should vet it

A lawyer, to check the genuineness-warranty, returns and credit clauses before signing.

Important cautions

AI-generated draft; make the supplier warrant parts are genuine/authentic (your brand rides on it) with recourse for counterfeits. A lawyer should review.
