Background

Checks whether the endorsements you require — additional insured, waiver of subrogation, primary & non-contributory — are actually present on a vendor certificate, and what to ask for if not. Use it to verify endorsements. For a full COI check, use the COI Review & Compliance Check.

Purpose of this tool & output

Verify a vendor certificate has the endorsements you need

How the output is used

Use it to verify a vendor certificate actually carries the endorsements — additional insured, waiver, primary/non-contributory — you need.

Who should vet it

An insurance broker, to confirm the endorsement forms are the correct ones.
