Background

Draft an interior design services agreement between a designer and a client — scope and deliverables, design stages and approvals, fees and payment, revisions and IP, and liability — for a design-only engagement. Fill in the terms below.

Purpose of this tool & output

Contract design work clearly

How the output is used

Use the draft to contract design work clearly — scope, deliverables, fees, revisions, IP and timeline — then have a lawyer review it.

Who receives it

The agreement is between the design firm and the client; each keeps a signed copy.

Fees & charges

Stamp duty per your state stamp act; GST is handled in invoicing.

Who should vet it

A lawyer, to check the scope, revisions, IP-ownership and payment clauses before signing.

Important cautions

AI-generated draft; have a lawyer review before signing.
