Background

Draft an agreement to engage a freelance interior professional — 3D artist, designer, draughtsperson or consultant — covering scope, fees, deliverables, IP and confidentiality, for project-based work. Fill in the terms below.

Purpose of this tool & output

Engage freelance designers and 3D artists

How the output is used

Use the draft to engage freelance designers and 3D artists — scope, fee, IP assignment, timeline and confidentiality — reviewed by a lawyer.

Who receives it

The agreement is between the firm and the freelancer/consultant; each keeps a signed copy.

Fees & charges

Usually executed on stamp paper per your state; GST/TDS apply to the fee as per law.

Who should vet it

A lawyer, to make the IP-assignment, deliverable and confidentiality clauses clear so the work-product IP vests in the firm.

Important cautions

AI-generated draft; have a lawyer review before signing.
