Background

Draft a turnkey (design + execution) interior contract between a firm and a client — scope and specifications, price and payment stages, timeline, variations, quality/warranty, and liability — for a design-build project. Fill in the terms below.

Purpose of this tool & output

Contract design-and-build safely

How the output is used

Use the draft to contract design-and-build safely — scope, BOQ, milestones, variations, defect liability and payment — reviewed by a lawyer.

Who receives it

The agreement is between you (design-build contractor) and the client; each keeps a signed copy.

Fees & charges

Stamp duty on the contract value per your state stamp act; GST is handled in invoicing.

Who should vet it

A lawyer, to check the variation, penalty, defect-liability and payment-milestone clauses before signing a turnkey contract.

Important cautions

AI-generated draft; turnkey contracts carry execution risk - have a lawyer review before signing.
