

SaaS Contract Review (Data & Security)

IT & Tech Compliance

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Reviews a SaaS agreement/DPA focused on data and security terms — data ownership, deletion, sub-processors, audit rights, breach notification, liability and exit — with suggested language and must-negotiate points. Use this for a data-focused review; for commercial terms use the MSA / Order-Form Reviewer and for a pure DPA use the DPA Reviewer.

Purpose of this tool & output

Upload a SaaS vendor agreement focused on data processing and security terms

How the output is used

Use the review to check a SaaS vendor agreement on data-processing and security terms before you sign.

Who receives it

For your internal use and your lawyer; the vendor is not a recipient of the review.

Fees & charges

No government fee; a lawyer charges a professional fee for a formal opinion.

Who should vet it

A technology/data-protection lawyer, for the DPA, security, liability and exit terms.

Important cautions

AI-generated review. Have a technology lawyer review before signing, especially for data-intensive deployments.
