How the output is used

Use the draft to engage an independent consultant cleanly — scope, fees, IP, confidentiality and independent-contractor status.

Who receives it

The agreement is between the company and the consultant; each keeps a signed copy.

Fees & charges

Usually on nominal stamp paper; the fee, IP and independent-contractor terms are the key content.

Who should vet it

A lawyer, to keep the IP, confidentiality and contractor-status clauses sound so the consultant is not deemed an employee.

Important cautions

AI-generated draft; a lawyer should review.
