Background

Structure a provisional patent specification for Indian filing — title, field, background and problem, summary, description and advantages — with a novelty caution and the next steps to a complete specification. Fill in the details below.

Purpose of this tool & output

Structure a provisional patent application

How the output is used

Use it to structure a provisional patent application — a provisional specification that secures a priority date before the complete spec.

Who receives it

The provisional application is filed with the Indian Patent Office under the Patents Act, establishing a priority date.

How to submit / file it

File the provisional specification with the form and drawings; a complete specification must follow within 12 months to keep the priority.

Fees & charges

Government filing fees by applicant type (individual/startup/others); patent-agent fees are extra.

Who should vet it

A patent agent/attorney, to draft the provisional spec and claims scope correctly to protect the priority.

Important cautions

AI-generated outline; a patent agent/attorney should draft claims and file; poor drafting can lose rights.
