Who receives it

The opposition/rectification is filed with the Trademark Registry against the applicant/registrant.

How to submit / file it

File the notice of opposition (within the opposition window) or rectification with grounds and evidence; pleadings and a hearing follow per the rules.

Who should vet it

A trademark attorney, to settle the grounds, evidence and pleadings and to argue the matter.

Important cautions
