Background

Guides CDSCO import clearance for drugs, medical devices, diagnostics and cosmetics — registration/licence forms (e.g. MD-14/15, drug Form 10), the SUGAM/CDSCO process, and documents. Use it before importing regulated health products. For food, use the FSSAI Import Clearance Guide.

Clear medical and drug imports

How the output is used

Use the guide to clear medical and drug imports through CDSCO with the right import licence/registration.

Who receives it

The Central Drugs Standard Control Organisation (CDSCO), via the SUGAM portal.

How to submit / file it

Apply on SUGAM for the import registration/licence with the dossier and fees for your product category.

Fees & charges

Application/registration fees per category, as notified by CDSCO.

Who should vet it

A drug-regulatory consultant experienced with CDSCO imports.
