

DG Declaration Generator

Logistics & Trade

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Drafts a Dangerous Goods Declaration (Shipper Declaration) in the standard format with all required entries for the mode. Use it to prepare the DG paperwork — note only DG-trained personnel may sign it. To confirm packaging first, use the DG Packing & Labelling Guide.

Purpose of this tool & output

Draft a Shipper Declaration for dangerous goods

How the output is used

Use the generator to draft a Shipper Declaration for dangerous goods with the correct UN and class details.

Important cautions

AI-generated draft; only DG-trained personnel may sign; carrier acceptance required.
