Background

Produces a setup plan for a maritime business — segment, DG Shipping and port approvals, assets and a phased roadmap. Use it to start out. For a funding document use the Maritime Business Plan.

Purpose of this tool & output

Use it as your first roadmap into a maritime or shipping business — the segment, entity, approvals and setup, then move to the full plan.

Important cautions

Maritime is capital-heavy for ships and ports and heavily regulated by DG Shipping, port authorities and IMO conventions; requirements vary by segment. Confirm the exact approvals for your segment and budget accordingly before committing.
