Background

Builds a terminal-operations and productivity plan — berth and yard and gate and equipment planning, throughput and turnaround KPIs and bottlenecks — to maximise terminal performance. Use it to run or improve a terminal.

Purpose of this tool & output

How the output is used

Use it to run a terminal for throughput — a terminal operations and productivity guide that raises berth and yard efficiency.

Important cautions

Terminal productivity depends on berth, yard, equipment and evacuation working together; evacuation and congestion are common bottlenecks. Benchmark KPIs and address the binding constraint, not just quay-side speed.
