Background

Builds a planned-maintenance and drydocking plan — the planned maintenance system, class surveys and drydock scope and budget and downtime — to keep the vessel in class and airworthy of sea. Use it to manage vessel upkeep.

How the output is used

Use it to plan planned maintenance and drydocking — a maintenance and drydock plan that keeps the vessel class-compliant and reliable.

Important cautions

Vessel maintenance and class surveys are airworthiness-equivalent obligations and lapses risk detention and loss of class; drydocking is costly and causes off-hire. Align with class and the survey cycle and plan drydock scope and budget carefully.
