Background

Produces a setup plan for a container freight station (CFS), inland container depot (ICD) or port-linked warehouse — approvals, customs, infrastructure and operations. Use it to plan a CFS, ICD or bonded warehouse.

Purpose of this tool & output

Set up a CFS, ICD or port warehouse

How the output is used

Use it to set up a CFS, ICD or port warehouse — the approvals, infrastructure and customs bonding a facility needs.

Important cautions

CFS and ICD setup needs customs notification and bonding and specific approvals and depends on port and rail connectivity and cargo. Confirm the current approval and customs requirements and validate cargo and connectivity before investing.
