

Collaboration Agreement

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Drafts a creator-to-creator collaboration agreement under Indian law: ownership of content/channel, revenue split, responsibilities, IP, credit, dispute and exit. Use this when two creators co-produce work. For a royalty-only split use Royalty Split Agreement.

Purpose of this tool & output

Creator-to-creator collaboration terms

How the output is used

Use the draft to set creator-to-creator collaboration terms — contribution, rights, revenue and credit.

Who receives it

The collaborating creators — all sign; a copy each.

Fees & charges

Stamp duty per your state; revenue attracts GST/TDS where applicable.

Who should vet it

A media/IP lawyer, for the IP ownership, revenue-split and credit clauses.

Important cautions

AI-generated draft; a lawyer should review.
