

Creator & Talent Contract Review

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Reviews a creator or talent contract from the perspective of the party you name, extracting key commercial terms with risk ratings, IP and usage provisions, red flags, missing protections and negotiation priorities. Use this before signing a brand deal or talent agreement. To draft a new brand deal instead of reviewing one, use Influencer Brand-Deal Drafter.

Purpose of this tool & output

Upload a brand deal, creator agreement or talent contract for key term extraction

How the output is used

Use the review to extract key terms in a brand deal, creator or talent contract before you sign.

Who receives it

For your internal use and your lawyer; the counterparty is not a recipient of the review.

Fees & charges

No government fee for the review; a lawyer charges a professional fee for a formal opinion.

Who should vet it

A media/entertainment lawyer, for the rights, exclusivity, usage and payment clauses.

Important cautions

AI-generated review. Have an entertainment lawyer review before signing.
