

Grant / Film-Fund Application

Media & Entertainment

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Drafts a grant/film-fund application narrative: project summary, artistic vision, significance and impact, feasibility, budget summary and team, with a tip to align to the funds priorities. Use this to apply to a film fund or grant. For a commercial investor deck use Investor / Funding Pitch Deck.

Purpose of this tool & output

Draft a funding-application narrative

How the output is used

Use the drafted narrative to apply to a grant or film fund with a compelling, eligible funding case.

Who receives it

The grant body/film fund (a state film fund, NFDC-style body or private fund).

How to submit / file it

Submit via the fund portal/format by the deadline with the budget, plan and required annexures.

Who should vet it

A grant/line-production consultant, to align the application with the fund criteria.

Important cautions

AI-generated draft; adapt to the specific fund guidelines.
