Background

Drafts a royalty/revenue split agreement for creative collaborators, with a split table, the revenue sources covered and accounting terms. Use this to formalise how collaborators share income. For a full creator-to-creator partnership use Collaboration Agreement.

Purpose of this tool & output

Document a revenue/royalty split

How the output is used

Use the draft to document a revenue/royalty split among collaborators so payments are clear and disputes are avoided.

Who receives it

All revenue-sharing parties (co-creators/collaborators) — all sign; a copy each.

Fees & charges

Stamp duty per your state; payments attract GST/TDS where applicable.

Who should vet it

A media/IP lawyer, for the split percentages, accounting and audit-rights clauses.

Important cautions

AI-generated draft; a lawyer should review; register with relevant societies.
