Background

Turns a scene description into a structured music sync brief a supervisor or library can act on: musical direction, energy arc, ready-to-use search terms and licensing considerations. Use this to find the right track for a moment. For just the search keywords use Sync Search-Term Generator; to draft the licence terms use Music / Sync License Terms.

Purpose of this tool & output

Describe your scene and we draft a music sync brief for your music supervisor with search terms

How the output is used

Use the drafted sync brief with search terms to help your music supervisor find the right track for a scene.
