Use it to get SPCB Consent to Establish and Operate — the CTE and CTO a mine, crusher or processing unit needs before and during operation.

Who receives it

The State Pollution Control Board (Consent to Establish / Consent to Operate).

How to submit / file it

Apply on the state PCB portal with the project, effluent/emission and treatment details; category (red/orange/green) decides scrutiny.

Fees & charges

A fee based on category and project cost; validity and renewal vary by state and category.

Who should vet it

An environmental consultant for category, norms and treatment design.
