

Mining Surface Land Lease Agreement

Background

Draft a surface land lease agreement for mining-related use (storage, plant, haul road, dump) between a landowner and a mining operator — permitted use, rent and escalation, restoration, and term. Fill in the deal terms below.

Purpose of this tool & output

Lease surface land for mining use

How the output is used

Use the draft to lease surface land for mining use — rent, term, permitted use, restoration and liability — reviewed by a lawyer.

Who receives it

The lease is between the landowner (lessor) and the mine (lessee); each keeps a signed copy and it is registered.

Fees & charges

Stamp duty and registration per your state stamp act; the permitted-use, restoration and rent terms are the key content.

Who should vet it

A property lawyer, to verify land title and check the permitted-use, restoration and liability clauses before signing.
