

Mineral Transit Pass / e-Permit Guide

Purpose of this tool & output

Move minerals legally with valid permits

How the output is used

Use it to move minerals legally with valid permits — the transit pass or e-permit each dispatch needs to leave the mine.

Who receives it

The transit pass / e-permit is issued by the State Department of Mines and Geology (DMG), usually via the State online mineral e-permit (eRawanna-type) portal.

How to submit / file it

Generate a transit pass per dispatch with the paid royalty, quantity, grade, destination and vehicle details before the mineral moves.

Fees & charges

Royalty and any transit-pass/permit charge per the State rules; movement without a valid pass attracts penalty and seizure.

Who should vet it

The State DMG e-permit system and the dispatch officer, which validate royalty payment and quantity before issue.
