Background

Draft a mineral transport agreement between a mine and a transporter — route and quantity, rate per tonne-km or trip, transit pass and e-way bill responsibility, vehicle and overloading rules, and payment. Fill in the deal terms below.

Purpose of this tool & output

Contract mineral haulage on fair terms

How the output is used

Use the draft to contract mineral haulage on fair terms — rate, route, transit-pass responsibility, loss and liability — reviewed by a lawyer.

Who receives it

The agreement is between the mine and the transporter; each keeps a signed copy.

Fees & charges

Stamp duty per your state stamp act where applicable; the rate, transit-pass responsibility and loss/liability terms are the key content.

Who should vet it

A lawyer, to check the transit-pass responsibility, loss-in-transit and liability clauses before signing.
