Background

Explains 12A and 80G registration — 12A (income-tax exemption for the NGO) and 80G (deduction benefit for donors) — with the process (Form 10A/10AB on the income-tax portal, documents, provisional and final) and periodic revalidation. Use this to get tax exemption and donor deduction. Confirm the current process and take professional help.

Use the guide to get 12A tax exemption for the NGO and 80G deduction for donors.

Who receives it

The Income Tax Department (Commissioner of Income Tax, Exemptions).

How to submit / file it

Apply in Form 10A/10AB on the income-tax portal with the registration, accounts and activity details.

Who should vet it

A CA, for the 12A/80G application.
