

CSR Implementation Agreement

Nonprofit, NGO & Social Sector

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Drafts a CSR implementation agreement between a company and NGO — a clause-by-clause draft covering project scope and outcomes, funds and tranches, utilisation and unspent handling, reporting and audit, CSR compliance, IP and branding, monitoring and termination — with Schedule VII and CSR-rules alignment. Use this for a company-NGO CSR agreement. Align to CSR rules and have it legally reviewed.

Purpose of this tool & output

Agreement between company and NGO

How the output is used

Use the draft for a CSR implementation agreement between the company and the NGO on scope, funds and reporting.

Who receives it

The funding company and the implementing NGO — both sign; a copy each.

Fees & charges

Stamp duty per your state if it creates a stampable obligation; usually on stamp paper.

Who should vet it

A lawyer, for the CSR-rule, deliverable and utilisation-reporting clauses.

Important cautions
