

Foreign Donor / Grant Agreement

Nonprofit, NGO & Social Sector

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Drafts an FCRA-aware foreign donor grant agreement — a clause-by-clause draft covering grant purpose and use, FCRA compliance, reporting, no sub-granting to non-FCRA entities, audit, IP, termination and refund of unspent funds — with a note that funds flow via the designated account only. Use this for agreements with overseas funders. Align to FCRA and have it legally reviewed.

Purpose of this tool & output

Agreements with overseas funders

How the output is used

Use the draft to set an agreement with an overseas funder on scope, reporting and FCRA compliance.

Who receives it

The NGO and the foreign donor/agency — both sign; a copy each.

Fees & charges

Usually on the organisation letterhead; stamp duty only if it creates a stampable obligation.

Who should vet it

A lawyer/FCRA consultant, for the FCRA and utilisation clauses.

Important cautions

AI-generated template; align to FCRA and have it legally reviewed.
