Background

Builds a governance self-audit — area by area (board and governance, policies, compliance, financial oversight, safeguarding, transparency) with checks, a Strong/Adequate/Weak scorecard and priority fixes. Use this to assess your governance health. Strengthen governance continuously. For overall health use the Organisational Health Audit.
