Who receives it

The agreement/terms are between the business and the pet owner; each keeps a signed copy.

Fees & charges

Usually on plain paper or as accepted terms; the scope, liability and cancellation terms are the key content.

Who should vet it

A lawyer, to check the liability, consent and cancellation clauses before you rely on it.

Important cautions

AI-generated draft; include health-disclosure, emergency-consent and liability terms and have a lawyer review before use.
