Background

Register a pet shop / animal-selling business

How the output is used

Use it to register a pet shop or animal-selling business — the registration under the Pet Shop Rules a pet retail/animal business needs.

Who receives it

The registration is with the State Animal Welfare Board (SAWB), under the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (Pet Shop) Rules (PCA Act).

How to submit / file it

Apply with the premises, housing, veterinary tie-up and welfare-compliance details; an inspection of the premises precedes registration.

Fees & charges

A registration fee and periodic renewal per the rules; operating an unregistered pet shop attracts penalty and closure.

Who should vet it

A veterinarian and the State Animal Welfare Board, which inspect the premises and welfare before registration.

Important cautions
