Background

Identifies the licences for a chemical or API manufacturing unit — factory licence, pollution consent, hazardous chemical, PESO/explosives if applicable, drug licence for API, fire — with the authority and when each is needed, in priority order. Use this to know the licences for chemical manufacture. Requirements vary by product and state; confirm locally.
