Background

Drafts a conduct and compliance policy for a pharma company — principles (data integrity, quality-first, UCPMP compliance, confidentiality, safety), prohibited practices (data falsification, unethical promotion) and consequences. Use this to set ethics and conduct for pharma staff, aligned to GMP, UCPMP and law.
